Wilson Plovers breed in the se. United States and throughout Mexico to n. S America, n. populations migrating to some extent, and vagrants recorded N to c. California and s. Canada (AOU 1998, CBRC 2007). One reported 12-13 Sep 2000 from Tern I, French Frigate was well described but the description failed to consider or eliminate Greater Sand-Plover (*C. leschenaultii*), one of which turned up the following Jan in California (CBRC 2007). Could it have been the same individual Greater Sand-Plover (*cf.* Abbott et al. 2001)?
