Royal Tern Thalasseus maximus

hypothetical, unsubstantiated

A report of a Royal Tern from Kealia Pond NWR, Maui, 21 Feb 2002, did not have enough details to eliminate Elegant (*T. elegans*) or <u>Caspian</u> terns. Royal Terns occur along temperate Atlantic and Pacific American coasts, with vagrants recorded throughout N America and to Europe and Africa (AOU 1998), and it would be a possible vagrant to the Hawaiian Islands, as would Elegant Tern, of which there is a specimen record for Johnston Atoll (USNM 544937, collected 19 Apr 1969; <u>HRBP</u> 5072-5073).
