

De Filippi's Petrel

Pterodroma defilippiana

hypothetical, erroneous report

This species breeds in the Juan Fernandez Is off Chile and disperses into the Humboldt Current off w. S America. The AOU (1989) temporarily changed the English name of this species to “Juan Fernandez Petrel” and then attributed a sight report of *Pterodroma externa* (see [Juan Fernandez Petrel](#)) in Hawaiian waters to *P. defilippiana*. This chain of errors was corrected by the AOU (1990, 1991). There are no other reports of De Filippi's Petrel from Hawaiian waters or those of the N Pacific.
