## Family ALINKIDAE

The family Alinkidae was proposed by Krzemiński (1992d) for the monobasic genus Alinka Krzemiński, 1992, known only from the Triassic Dan River Formation in the eastern United States. It marks the earliest record of Brachycera in the fossil record (if Crosaphididae is not a mythicomyiid—see under that chapter for more details). Krzemiński (1992) postulated that it was a member of the Tabanoidea, the classification of which is followed here.
