Family ANSORGIIDAE

The family Ansorgiidae was erected by Krzemiński & Lukashevitch (1993) based on the single genus *Ansorgia*. The family was placed by these authors as closely related to Ptychopteridae. Unfortunately, *Ansorgia* is preoccupied by *Ansorgia* Warren, 1899. A new replacement name, *Ansorgius* is proposed here by Wieslaw Krzemiński for *Ansorgia*.
