Family ARCHITENDIPEDIDAE

Rohdendorf (1962) erected this family based on two genera, *Architendipes* and *Palaeotendipes*. Hennig (1969c), basing his remarks solely on critiques of Rohdendorf's illustrations, stated that *Architendipes* and *Palaeotendipes* are most likely chironomids. Examination of type specimens are required to ascertain their true position among the nematocerous Diptera. Ashe (1983) treated both genera as "Incertae sedis".

Ross & Jarzemboski (1993: 398) listed the family as spanning the entire Triassic, though no literature records have been found by me to support this claim.
