

Family DIXAMIMIDAE

The family Dixamimidae is known only from the single extinct genus *Dixamima* Rohdendorf, from the Jurassic deposits of Karatau, Kazakhstan. There is some contention that the validation of the genus-group name and its type species date not from Rohdendorf (1951), but rather the description in Rohdendorf (1962). All works in which the name has been proposed are listed here. Rohdendorf (1964) classified the family between his superfamilies Eoptychopteridea and Culicidea in the Dixidea. The genus is known only from the single male holotype of *Dixamima villosa*.

Genus DIXAMIMA Rohdendorf
