

Family EOPHLEBOMYIIDAE

Cockerell (1924*a*) originally described the fossil fly listed below as an acalypterate in the Tephritidae. Subsequent research by F.W. Edwards *in* Cockerell (1925*b*) showed that *Eophlebomyia* was a calypterate fly more closely related to Glossinidae and Anthomyiidae. Cockerell (1925*b*) agreed with Edwards' conclusions and erected the family Eophlebomyiidae.

Genus EOPHLEBOMYIA Cockerell
