

Family PROCAMPTONOMYIIDAE

The family Procamptomomyiidae was originally proposed based on two species in the genus *Procamptomomyia* Kovalev from the Jurassic deposits of Siberia. Krzemiński (1992) added the genus *Yala* from the Upper Triassic deposits of the Dan River Formation of the eastern United States. Kalugina & Kovalev (1985) claimed that the family is closely related to Cramptomomyiidae (treated in this catalog within the family Pachyneuridae).
