

Family TIPULOPLECIIDAE

The family Tipulopleciidae is an extinct group of flies related to Plecofungivoridae. Rohdendorf (1964) surmised that characters of the fossil impression such as long thin legs and wings reflect the limited capabilities of flight and running of this fly. Tipulopleciids are known only from the single fossil impression of a presumed male lying on its side.
