

**SIMULIUM (MOROPS) LONGIROSTRIS NOM. NOV.,
A REPLACEMENT NAME FOR SIMULIUM
ROSTRATUM SMART & CLIFFORD, 1965**
(Diptera : Simuliidae)

I am indebted to Dr Alan Stone of Washington and Dr Jan E. Raastad of Oslo for drawing my attention to the fact that *S. rostratum* Smart & Clifford, 1965, is a junior secondary homonym in *Simulium* Latreille of *S. rostratum* (Lundström, 1911), and that a new specific epithet is required. I am also indebted to Dr Roger W. Crosskey of London for taking a critical interest in the matter. The relevant details are set out below.
