1 ♀ (BISHOP), Beeman Hill, 100–180 m, Campbell I., sooty albatross nest, 11–16.XII.1961, J. L. Gressitt.

Widely distributed over all tropic and subtropic regions of Africa, Asia and Australia, even in Southern Europe and North America.
