***Megaselia (Megaselia) scalaris* (Loew)**

Phora scalaris Loew, 1866, Cent. 7: 53.

1 ♀ (BISHOP), Beeman Hill, 100-180 m, Campbell I., sooty albatross nest, 11-16.XII.1961, J. L. Gressitt.

Widely distributed over all tropic and subtropic regions of Africa, Asia and Australia, even in Southern Europe and North America.
